- 1. The issue of re-imbursement of the dues would be dealt with on the adjourned date.
- 2. Members of the petitioner-institution who are operating private school cannot refuse to abide by the mandate of law. The requirement provided under Right to Education Act of admitting 25% of the students from disadvantage group and weaker section as per the list furnished by the Education Officer shall have to be strictly observed. In the event of failure of the school to abide by the mandate, it would be open for the competent authority to take appropriate steps as permissible in law.
