The minor-petitioner, through her father, is aggrieved against the striking off her name from the rolls of the school on account of the non-deposit of the fees vide communication dated 16.11.2016 (Annexure P-5).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ashish Chopra, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent no. 3/Caveator.

It is pointed out by Mr. Chopra that various notices had been sent to the petitioner and there were arrears of fee to be paid by the petitioner to the tune of ₹19,130/- as on 22.10.2016. Mr. Chopra further submits that now the amount has swelled to around ₹24,000/-.

Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the father of the petitioner, submits that he will deposit the amount in installments and the child be re-admitted. Accordingly, counsel for the petitioner submits that the amount may be divided into three instalments which, the petitioner will pay by 31.12.2016, 31.01.2017 and 28.02.2017.

Ordered accordingly.

On the deposit of the first instalment, the child will be readmitted in the school without any additional charges of any penalty or additional fee for the readmission.

In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of, without prejudice to the pending litigation as such qua other parties before the Appellate Forum.
